Essential Functions and Responsibilities

- Operate Delta press while using touch screen functions
- Read, analyze and interpret customers' drawings, measurements and tolerances including blueprints and job tickets
- Produce dimensionally accurate medical or non-medical products
- Performs inspection to ensure product meets stringent quality standards and customer specifications
- Maintains clean and organized press area at all times
- Set-up and insert rotary dies
- Adjust gear ratios and re-registration within the press
- Splices roll material together
- Adjusts speed, tension, and alignment as necessary to ensure quality product
- Attaches, operates, and detaches finishing equipment used on press
- Removes waste rolls and finished rolls from press
- Completes job related documentation
- Tracks time and materials used at press by entering data in job costing module. (LabelTraxx)
- Laminate multiple materials and adhesives
- Maintain production efficiency while producing high-quality products
- Performs daily preventative maintenance.
